As an influential medium, BBC Persian reflects the engagement of the Iranian diaspora with global issues, while maintaining cultural connections and providing a space for diverse voices. Its programming supports the diaspora's efforts to stay informed and connected, bridging the gap between Iranians at home and abroad (The Open University 2025).

Founded in 1989 by Alireza Amirghassemi and Masoud Jamali, it has become a prominent platform for Persian-language entertainment and cultural programming. Its official website, [www.tapes.tv](http://www.tapes.tv), offers global access to live broadcasts and on-demand content.

Operating 24/7, Tapes features a wide range of content including talk shows, music concerts, films, series, red carpet events, and cultural specials. The channel is well known for promoting Iranian pop culture and connecting artists, entertainers, and audiences across the diaspora.

With satellite offices in cities such as New York, Vancouver, London, Dubai, Kuala Lumpur, and Sydney, Tapes reaches viewers across North America, Europe, the Middle East, and Australia. Through its widespread presence and diverse programming, it plays a key role in maintaining cultural ties and fostering community among Iranians living abroad (Tapes n.d.).
